Visibility Tracking Locker

The Challenge

The Baltimore Police Department was in a unique situation, they already had smart lockers in place, but their lockers were not capable of what Meridian could offer. The police department wanted a solution for the modern demands of the job and that had the ability for safe and secure transfers of equipment and other items throughout the day, specifically between departments, with the ability to keep electronic records of all usage reports.

“This software allows all items to be tied to a 4-digit code and keeps an internal record of all transactions made at the locker automatically.

The Solution

Meridian created a whole new software to go along with an entirely new set of smart lockers for the precinct. Meridian's Visibility Tracking Lockers allows items to be loaded by administrators to load various lockers across departments all over their jurisdiction. Once the equipment was loaded an automatic notification, either by text or email, is sent out to the recipient indicating they have an item for pick up.

When the recipient comes to pick up the item, they input a specific 4-digit alphanumeric sequence ID, allowing for internal records of all transactions made at the locker automatically. Once the recipient was finished using the equipment, they simply schedule a return time and follow the return instructions automatically sent to them.



Increasing efficiency and transparency across the entire police department. Upon closing the door an automatic notification is sent to the admin indicating a successful return of the equipment and the system automatically keeps an internal record of all transactions and resets the door to the "Ready State" making it available for another use.
